HOW DID IT START?

I always had plans to start an NGO to address some of the challenges faced by the community since my graduation days. After a few years, I have focused on animal welfare as the challenges faced by animals are many. I understood that I could solve these challenges only by engaging everyone in animal welfare.

There are many instances where I observed animals drinking water and eating food from the sewage, due to a lack of access to these resources, because of human developments.

I was stimulated by the fact that safeguarding animal welfare and rights has a tremendous positive impact on humans and the environment. At this point, I was convinced more to focus on the upliftment of animal welfare.

I felt there is a need to create a platform where quickly people get to understand and engage in protecting animal welfare and rights in the community.

Hence, I initiated a project which focuses primarily on WATER & EDUCATION concerning animals in the community. This project transforms people into leaders for animals in the community.

Today, human actions are polluting and destroying animal habitats. We observed a vast gap formed between humans and animals due to human ignorance and lack of awareness. On the other side, animals are not getting healthy food, drinking water, shelter, medication around the year due to the destruction caused by humans.





THE JOURNEY

Animals Water Bowl Project (AWBP) Trust started on 14th April'17. We started with an intention to provide water bowls for free to the public to support street animals. Later on, we added a continuous education program as part of the vision to create a bigger impact. Officially legalized AWBP Trust on 18th Feb'20. Now we are a team of 3 trustees and 15 volunteers across the globe who are working with us.

Animals Water Bowl Project(AWBP) Trust vision is to create a platform where every street animal gets safe drinking water round the clock throughout the year and connect humans with animals through a continuous education program.


GRANTEE AT TPP, US


EDUCATIONAL SONG


